

Message from the Assistant Dean

Subject line: Faculty of Science Classes to Resume Tuesday, March 17th

Dear Faculty of Science Student,

We are pleased to inform you that the Executive Committee of the York University Senate has approved resumption of Faculty of Science classes as of tomorrow, Tuesday March 17th.

We await, and will send, further details as they become available. In the meantime, please take note of the following:

- a) Since the labour disruption is ongoing, tutorials and labs may not be active. Please consult your course instructors for details regarding the tutorials and labs associated with your course(s).
- b) Some assignments may not be graded until after the disruption has been fully resolved.
- c) Adjustments to class schedules and normal academic regulations will be necessary. Although more and final details will still be determined, it has currently been established that:
 - a. There will be a reduction in the length of the Y and W terms of seven days. We will send you more details as they are finalised.
 - b. The formal examination schedule will begin later than originally planned. We will send you information as details are resolved.
- d) As a reminder, please note that the deadline to withdraw from courses has been extended. We will send the new deadline date once that date has been determined.

Please be aware that, in keeping with York University Senate Policy, due to the ongoing labour disruption students who are unable or unwilling to participate in academic activities because of the disruption are entitled to immunity from penalty, to reasonable alternative access to materials covered in their absence, and to reasonable extensions of deadlines and/or other forms of remediation.
